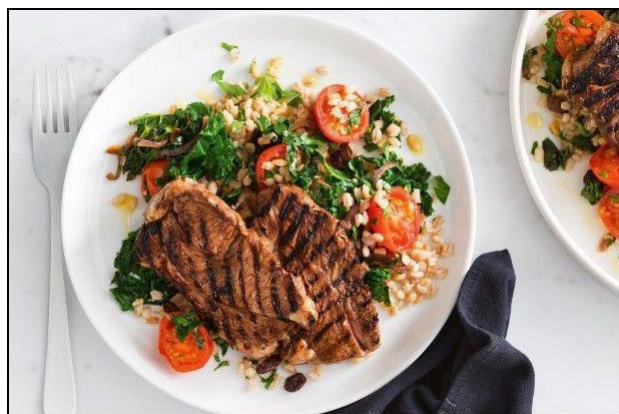




‘Let’s Talk About Food’

Food culture in Australia

- Describe a normal breakfast you have at home in Australia.
- How often do you get ‘takeaway’ food that you buy that someone else cooks?
- Who normally prepares the meals in your home? And how many people does the person cook for?
- How often do you go to a café or restaurant to eat a meal there?
- Do you look at recipes in books or magazines for ideas on what to cook?
- Talk about what you would eat as a typical evening meal in your home in Australia.
- Where do you shop for your fruit and vegetables?
- Do you watch MasterChef or other cooking programs on television?
- Where do you buy your meat and fish - at a market, supermarket or elsewhere?
- Do you ever visit restaurants serving food from your own country or food from other countries, for example Chinese, Indian, Burmese, Greek and Japanese.
